Commands Used By Braveheart Kennels

- Sit To have dog sit with good posture, not on side of rump.
- Heel To have dog at left side head at knee.
- Stay Not to move from position when command was given.
- No Stop what your doing now.
- Here To call to your side.
- Lay down To lie down.
- Hunt um up Release command to find birds.
- Find em Dead To look for a dead or wounded bird.
- Birds in here Used when asking dog to hunt a particular spot of cover.
- Fetch it up To pick up or retrieve a bumper or a bird.
- Dogs Name Release from heel to retrieve, and other releases.
- Back To go back further. Or release to blind retrieve.
- Over To go to the left or right.
- Hold To hold bumper or bird in mouth until told to do otherwise.
- Give To release bird or bumper from mouth to hand.
- Kennel To go into crate, kennel, car, blind, or anything.
- Mark To have dog look at falling bird or bumper location.
- Whoa To freeze on Point.
- Hold To hold in mouth until asked to release.

Whistle Commands for Retrievers

One long blast.	Sit.
Series of short blasts.	Here.
Quiet tweets.	You're near the bird start using your nose.

Whistle Commands for Pointers

Series of short blasts.	Here.
One short blast.	Change Direction.
